Annai Veilankanni's Educational and Cultural Society, Saidapet, Chennai-15, was founded in 1988 with the mission of serving the educational needs of the student community in and around Chennai. Over the decades, the Society has grown into a trusted educational network, establishing schools and colleges at Saidapet, Nedungundram, Potheri, and Perungalathur. Guided by a long-standing vision to promote accessible and quality higher education, the Management aspired to create an institution that would support students at Saidapet and the surrounding suburban regions by providing a conducive academic environment.

Fulfilling this vision, the Arts and Science College was established in 2000 at Saidapet. The institution received approval from the Government of Tamil Nadu (G.O. No. 296 dated 10.07.2000 and G.O. CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (CBCS)

The College follows the **Choice Based Credit System (CBCS)** as mandated by the **University of Madras**. To be eligible for the award of a degree, a student must:

- Complete the prescribed course of study at a college affiliated to the University for a minimum of three academic years.
- Successfully pass all six semesters of the programme.
- Earn at least 140 credits across Part I, II, III, IV, and V as per the credit distribution framework.
- Fulfil all additional academic and administrative requirements prescribed by the University.

COURSE STRUCTURE (As per University of Madras Regulations)

The College follows the course structure and credit distribution framework prescribed by the University of Madras under the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS). A minimum of 140 credits must be earned to qualify for the award of the degree.

- **SEC-1:** For students who studied Tamil up to XII Std and have chosen Tamil in Part I.
- **Basic Tamil:** For students who did not study Tamil up to XII Std and have taken another language in Part I.
- **Advanced Tamil:** For students who studied Tamil up to XII Std but opted for another language in Part I.

CURRICULUM FRAMEWORK

EVALUATION SYSTEM

Formative Assessment (Internal – 25 Marks)

- Evaluation based on Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA), is conducted periodically which includes Tests, Attendance, Seminars, Assignments, etc.

Summative Assessment (External – 75 Marks)

- University of Madras conducts Semester Examination at the end of each semester.

Passing Criteria

- Minimum 40% in external examination
- Minimum 40% overall (internal + external)

Attendance

- Students must maintain a minimum of 75% attendance in each semester to be eligible to appear for the End Semester University Examination.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

How to apply

- Visit the College website (www.avcas.annaiveilankannis.com) and click **APPLY NOW**
- New User, click on “**CLICK HERE TO REGISTER**” under New Applicant by entering basic details such as name, date of birth, mobile number, email ID, and password. The System will generate a **USER ID** and **OTP** and also send SMS and EMAIL to the Registered Mobile No. and EMAIL. If you have already registered, enter your **USER ID** and **PASSWORD** to login.

Eligibility Criteria

- Students from Tamil Nadu State Board and CBSE are eligible to apply directly.
- Students from other State must submit an Eligibility Certificate from the University of Madras at the time of admission.
- All admissions are provisional and subject to verification of mark certificates by the Director of Government Examinations.
- Foreign students must submit:
 - a) No Objection Certificate of HRD, Government of India
 - b) Eligibility Certificate from the University of Madras
 - c) Valid student visa

Fee Payment

- Selected candidates must pay the prescribed fee in cash or online at the College Office immediately upon selection.
- Fee once paid will not be refunded. Students dismissed on disciplinary grounds will have to forfeit the entire fee.
- Failure to pay the fees promptly may lead to cancellation of admission

Withdrawals

A student once enrolled for a course is expected to complete the same. If a student wishes to leave the college at any time before the completion of course, the student has to clear all the dues.



PLACEMENT & CAREER GUIDANCE

The Placement Cell has been consistently striving to empower students by providing career guidance, industry exposure, skill development, and employment opportunities. Through various placement drives, workshops, and training programmes conducted during the academic year 2025-2026, the institution strengthened its commitment towards enhancing students' employability and bridging the gap between academia and industry.

A major highlight of the academic year was the successful organization of the Vetri Nichayam Placement Drive - 2026 on 21st January 2026 in collaboration with TN Skill, Government of Tamil Nadu, and Asgardia Foundation. Conducted as part of the institution's Silver Jubilee celebrations, the Mega Job Fair aimed to provide employment opportunities for unemployed youth and graduates from diverse educational backgrounds.

The Mega Job Fair witnessed the participation of more than 60 reputed companies offering over 3,000 job opportunities across sectors such as Information Technology, Banking, Finance, Manufacturing, Education, Engineering, Commerce, Pharmacy, Diploma, and Polytechnic streams. Around 2,700 candidates registered for the drive, among which 1,150 candidates were shortlisted and nearly 400 candidates received offer letters on the spot. The initiative successfully reinforced the institution's commitment to career empowerment and community development during its Silver Jubilee year.

Continuing its efforts to create meaningful employment opportunities, the college, in collaboration with Magic Bus India Foundation, organized another Mega Job Fair on 25th February 2026 at the college campus. The large-scale recruitment initiative brought together more than 50 reputed companies from various sectors and provided career opportunities for UG and PG graduates from all streams. Over 800 candidates from different institutions enthusiastically participated in the event, and more than 500 candidates received appointment orders.

Several reputed companies including Tech Mahindra, Tata Motors, ICICI Bank, Bandhan Bank, Axis Bank, HDB Financial Services, Shriram Finance, FITA Academy, and other organizations participated in the recruitment process. HR representatives conducted interviews, screening tests, and assessments throughout the day, making the event highly productive and impactful.

The Placement Cell also organized exclusive campus recruitment drives for final-year students in collaboration with reputed organizations. On 9th March 2026, a Placement Drive was conducted in association with QSpiders for final-year B.Sc. Computer Science and BCA students. The recruitment process included aptitude tests, technical assessments, and HR interviews, enabling students to gain valuable industry exposure and practical recruitment experience.

On 10th March 2026, another Placement Drive was organized in collaboration with FITA Training and Placement, Chennai, for final-year students of B.Sc. Computer Science, BCA, and B. Com CA. Students actively participated in aptitude tests, technical interviews, and HR discussions, gaining insights into current industry expectations and employment opportunities in the IT sector.

Further strengthening placement support, the college organized a Campus Placement Drive on 30th March 2026 in collaboration with Anudip Foundation, Chennai, exclusively for final-year BBA and B. Com students. The recruitment process included screening tests, aptitude evaluations, and personal interviews, helping students showcase their employability skills and professional readiness.

In addition to placement activities, the Entrepreneur Development Cell and Placement Cell jointly organized a Workshop on Lip Balm Making on 18th March 2026 to encourage entrepreneurship and self-employment opportunities among students. The workshop was conducted by Ms. U. Suganya, Co-Founder of Nayaa Organics, who provided practical training on organic lip balm preparation, packaging, and marketing strategies. The session inspired students to explore innovative business ideas and understand the scope of small-scale entrepreneurial ventures.

Through these initiatives, the Placement Cell continues to strengthen industry-institution interaction, improve students' professional competencies, and create meaningful career opportunities. The unwavering support of the management, faculty coordinators, industry partners, and alumni has played a significant role in achieving the institution's mission of empowering students with skills, confidence, and successful career pathways.

Value-added Certified Courses are offered in Yoga & Aerobics, Beautician Course, Soft Skills Development and Fine Arts. Training is provided for Bank Exams and Group I and II Exams. Annai Veilankanni's Academy for Skill Development & National Council for Vocational and Research Training provides diploma and certificate courses to all for a nourishing career.

Co-Curricular Activities

The College blends academic inputs with co-curricular activities. The hidden talents of the students are brought out through cultural events. ASTRAL is an Inter Collegiate Cultural Fest hosted every year in the college. Many city colleges participate in the Cultural Fest and explore the stars within themselves through the display of their amazing talents. The students are encouraged to participate in inter-collegiate, state and national level competitions. Inter- departmental competitions, AVC Fest is also conducted in the college every year. Each department organises its own club activities to bring out their curriculum potential of students
